3. Initiatives project

Since the January report to the Board, we held a video conference on the Beyond initiative on February 13, attended by about 40 people. A new web page has been set up for the project, and this is now also available in Spanish and Portuguese. This has registration details for the 2019 Turkey caravan events, and contact details for other caravan events. Details were sent in English to all dance leaders in a newsletter.

Crowd-funding donations for the project have reached \$790, and further sponsored attendance at UK and Russian dance camps has been obtained. Total sponsorship offered in 2019 amounts to \$3,380 approx.

Arjun is selecting from applicants from Africa and Asia for the next phase of the project.

A memorandum of understanding has now been signed with Global Ecovillage Network, addressing the Beyond Initiative.

4. Executive Director's report since the January 2019 meeting:

LG fee collection

Martha continues to be busy keeping fee collection up to date; the number of recurrent payments via Paypal continues to rise.

Dance resources

We continue to add walks, spins and other dance write-ups to the dance resource library. 23 have been added or edited so far this year. The explanation about how to access these has been simplified.

A <u>newsletter</u> has been sent out for the Beyond project (see above).

Web site: the page on the history of the dances is being translated into other languages.

Pen pals

Following interest sparked by the Beyond project, we are trialing a pen pal scheme, which will be announced in a newsletter:

Dance leaders - pen pals

The Leaders Guild is already a large family, with over 1000 mentored dance leaders, speaking more than a dozen languages, and spread across nearly 40 countries.

Now the <u>Beyond initiative</u> is set to bring the dances to further diverse areas in Africa and Asia.

It can be a wonderful experience to dance in a large circle with many nationalities and languages, to find our common ground in the legacy of Murshid SAM even when we may not have a common language with our neighbors. We may only rarely be able to travel, but we can connect in other ways heart to heart – by email, using skype or zoom.

Now some dance leaders are finding that they would like to build long distance connections with leaders and circles in other parts of the world, to share experiences, for example between California and Bosnia, and between cultural traditions.

We would like to facilitate such contacts, and NurAna Wilansky has kindly offered to co-ordinate such requests for 'pen pals'.

Possibilities for sponsorship might arise, between individuals or between dance circles, but the contact need not have a financial aspect. You may be looking to connect within your country, if distances are considerable, or be open to any opportunities, or be looking for a more specific dialogue. The established Leaders Guild <u>Agreements</u> will apply to these contacts.

You will be interested in developing and maintaining a contact over a sustained period of time, and we would like to hear from you maybe once or twice a year to share information in a newsletter. If this appeals to you, please contact Nur Ana here, with a brief context note of your situation and the type of contact you are seeking, and Nur Ana will try to match you to another dance leader with similar interests.
